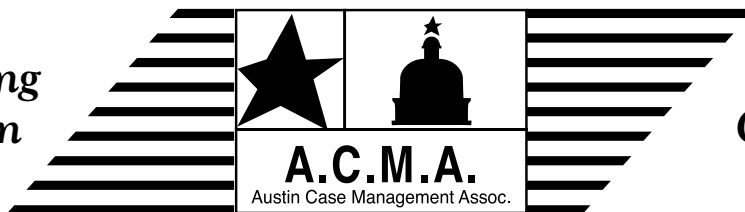

Our topic this month is "New Advancements in Asthma Treatment" by Dominic deKeraty, MD. This informative presentation reviews the components of Asthma and treatments for the disease. Dr. deKeraty highlights a new technology, Bronchial Thermoplasty, for the treatment of severe asthma. Bronchial Thermoplasty is used to complement asthma maintenance medications by providing long-lasting asthma control and improving asthma-related symptoms.

Dr. de Keraty has extensive experience in the performance of a wide-range of interventional pulmonology and pleural procedures. He completed his fellowship training in Pulmonary & Critical Care Medicine at Scott & White Memorial Hospital and TAMU Health Science Center in Temple with a special focus in the field of Interventional Pulmonology. He attended a sabbatical in Brussels, Belgium and Hemer, Germany developing expertise in therapeutic bronchoscopy as well as medical thoracoscopy. He is board certified in Pulmonology and Critical Care medicine and has presented work in the field of Interventional Pulmonology at International Meetings.

2011 Membership Directories

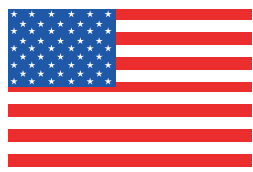
